is created in the style of NPR's, "This American Life." It tells compelling stories about Israeli life, and is very entertaining. Podcasts are available in both English and Hebrew.

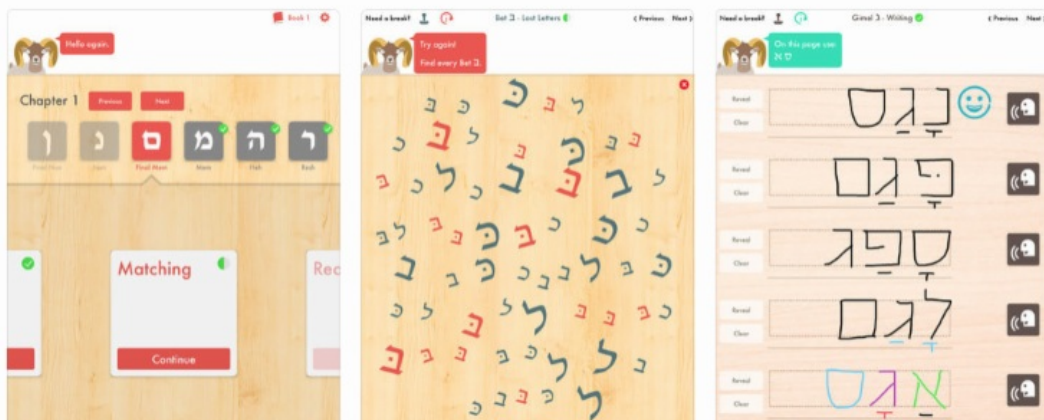
